 - to provide an environment which is engaging, enjoyable and fun for all

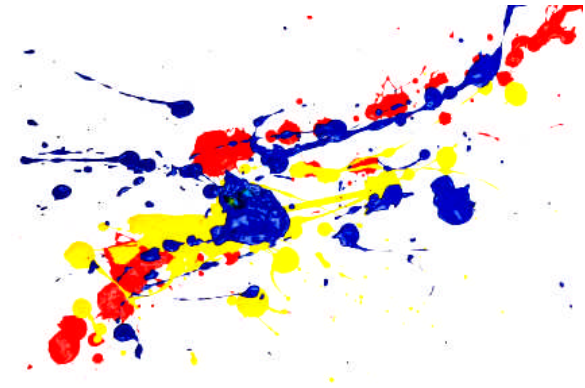

The Good News Club

The Good News Club is the collective name for the various children's groups (aged 0-11) at All Saints.

On Sunday morning (9.30am) children join with adults for the first part of the service and leave for their groups after about 15 minutes. This bit is designed with children in mind.

There is also a crèche (for 0-2 year olds) that runs in the Stable Block throughout



the entirety of the 9.30 service. Children can be left up to 15 minutes before the service starts.

If your child is difficult to leave, you are welcome to bring them into the church for the service. If you are worried about them being noisy, there is a room at the back of the church which can be used in an emergency.

Springers (reception age)
Climbers (school years 1 and 2)
Explorers (school years 3,4,5 & 6)
