## Read

Read Ephesians 6:10-24

## Discuss

1. How does verse 10 summarize so much of what Paul has been saying in his letter? (e.g. 1:19b-23; 2:4-7; 3:20-21; etc).
2. What is the devil's normal and oldest scheme to attack us (2:1-3)? How does this attack come to us in our everyday life as the church family? (Remember some of the things we've learned in chapters 3-6 particularly).
3. Given the nature of the spiritual battle (verse 12) why is 'standing firm' the best way of responding? What does this mean in practice?
4. Verses 13-17. The armour of God is something that we put on together as a church. (All the verbs are plural in the Greek). What does it look like in our life and relationships as a church for us to put on the armour of the gospel?
5. What makes the sword of the Spirit (verse 17) stand out from the other pieces of armour? How can we use this piece of armour in the spiritual battles we face?

## Pray

Pray for our life together in light of this passage. Are there specific things in this passage that we can pray for one another?

Pray also for the appointment of a new Music Minister and Seniors Pastor.
